5. ACCOMPANIST PIANIST

Competitors who request an accompanist pianist must send, along with the registration, copies of the scores and a fee of € 60.00.

6. Identification documents and copies of the performed pieces must be presented at the secretariat prior to the start of each audition.

7. The final judgment, in any case, will be expressed in hundredths, considering:

FIRST PRIZE	for scores from 95 to 100
SECOND PRIZE	for scores from 90 to 94
THIRD PRIZE	for scores from 85 to 89
HONORABLE MENTION	for scores from 80 to 84

8. The winners must participate free of charge in the award concerts, failing which the prize will be revoked, and they will not be entitled to any compensation for audio-video or radio-television recordings.

9. The competitors will be admitted to the rehearsals in alphabetical order.

12. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

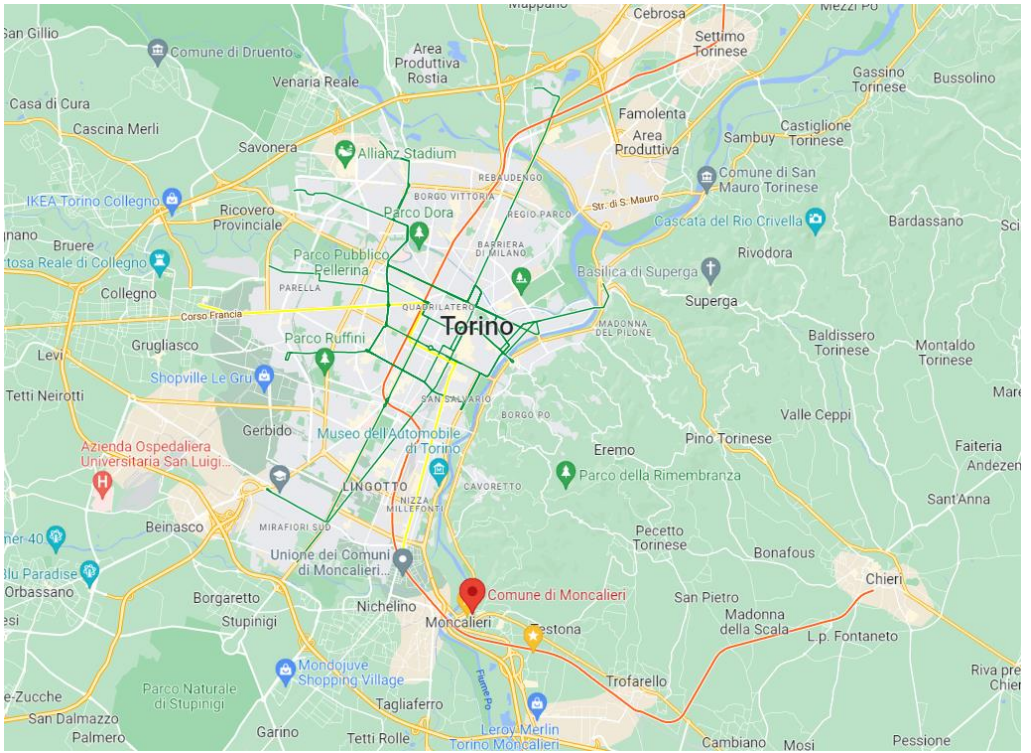

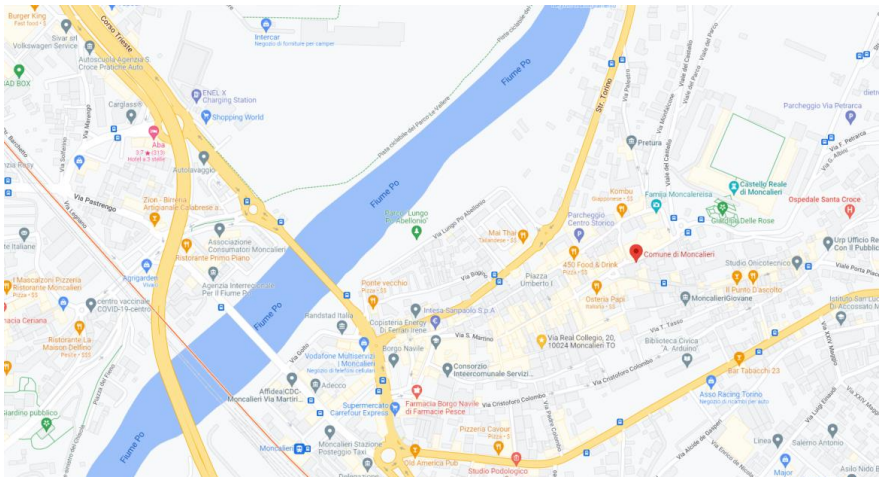


Map of Turin and Moncalieri

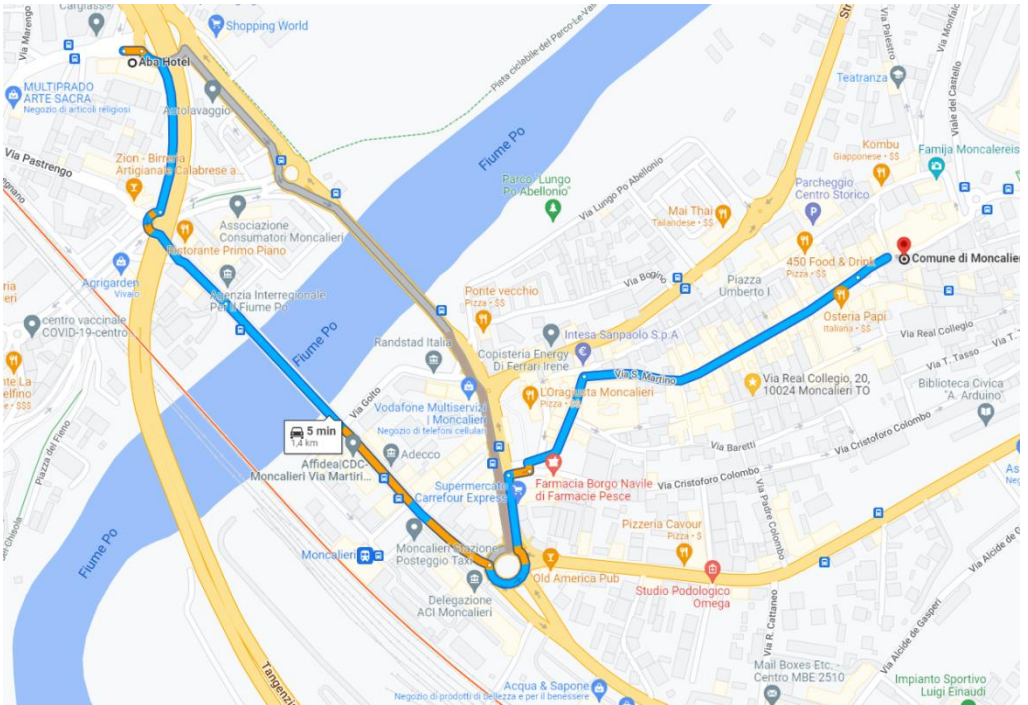
Royal Castle of Moncalieri and map of the historic centre
